



Parents as Partners

The primary leadership team shared some of the key differences that are in place for primary children this year: one of the main alterations for parents has been to the organisation of the timetable, with the prime morning learning time spent with their class teacher focusing on our key curriculum subjects of Phonics, Maths and English. They stressed the 'In & On Time; for learning and 'Fueled up for Learning' project as every day starts with Phonics at 8am. Additional teaching time is also allocated to these core subjects to enable teachers to continue to target and fill any gaps left remaining from the impact of the pandemic. All other subjects are included in the weekly timetable, including STEM which we know was very popular last year with both children and parents which commences for years FS2 – year 2 after half term and then will switch to years 3 to 5 from February to June.

The primary leadership team was also able to share with you some of the details of the 'Talk for Writing' approach to writing and the White Rose Maths programme. All baseline assessments will be complete before the half term break and this data will then inform various interventions planned to support children's learning. In addition, we were able to explain a few headlines about the exciting 'Positive Discipline' approach that we have commenced as a whole school. All of these key priorities this term are supported by additional workshops for parents on the following dates:

- 20th October: 8.30am: Positive Discipline for Parenting
- 3rd November: 8.30am: Phonic: How to practise Phonics at home with your child
- 17th November 8.30am: Maths: How to support your child in Maths
- 1st December 8.30am: Writing: Help your child write.
