- Ramadan Activities

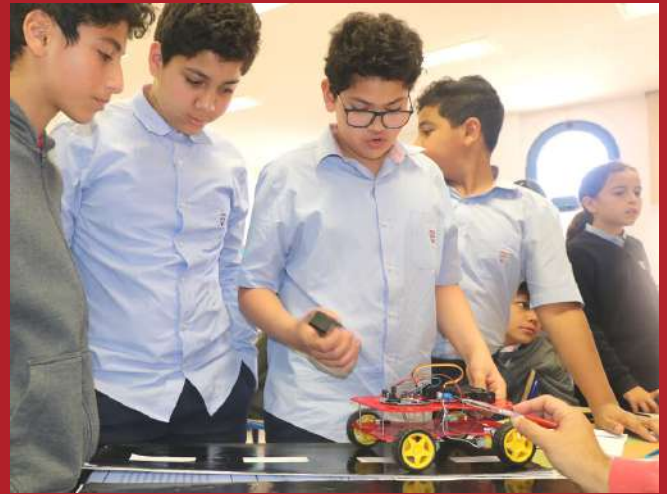


Getting Ready For The Science Fair
