Unifrog (Career Guidance) Workshop for Parents

On 11th of December, Y9 and Y10 parents were invited by the school's Exams Officer Mrs Mai Elshabrawy to a workshop as an introduction to the Unifrog Platform. Unifrog is a smart career guidance platform that offers tools to help the counsellors and parents guide students to understand themselves and be able to choose options supporting their choice universities and then their future careers. In this introductory session, parents were able to reflect on the importance of their children building this career profile as early as Y9 and Y10 to be able to make insightful decisions. The parents were also briefed on how to search by themselves about the university details. location. fees requirements, and other facts in the UK, USA, Egypt and around the world with one press of a button on Unifrog. Parents were engaged in a discussion about the importance of university rankings and the community pressure and how this influences their children. At the end of the workshop, the parents took the interests test themselves and they were very excited with the results, its explanation and how it reflects on their personality.
