

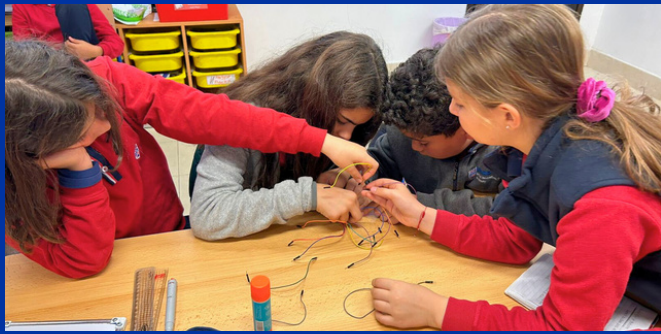
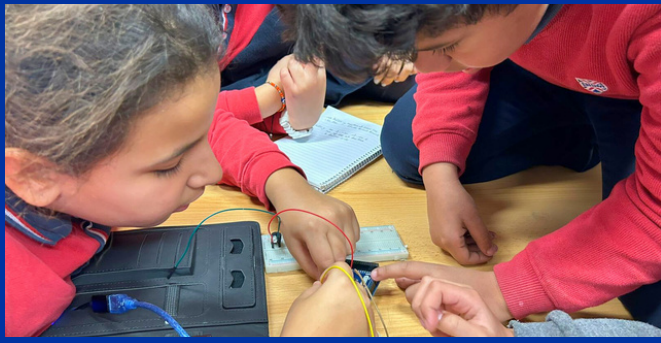
TEDxBISM YOUTH

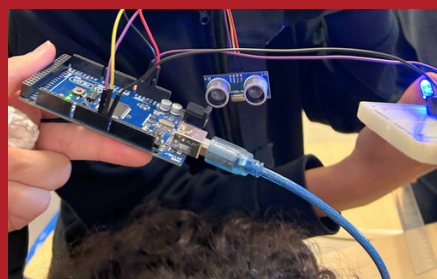
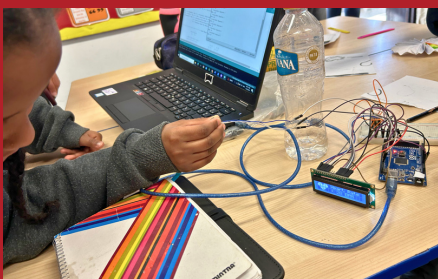
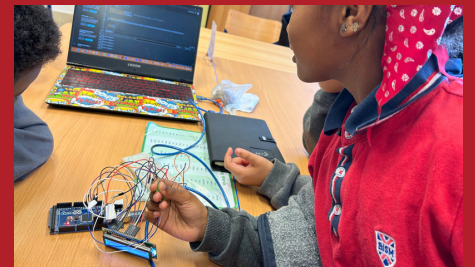
